Offered by Josh and Meghan Dishaw, RESTART, LLC medical education.

This will be a Heartsaver, CPR (adult, child and infant) and AED (automated external defibrillator) course that can be taken for general information or certification. During the course you'll be instructed on proper technique to administer high-quality chest compressions on someone in cardiac arrest, the Heimlich maneuver, choking relief for both responsive and unresponsive individuals, AED operation and First Aid. If you would like a certification card, the American Heart Association charges \$20.

A4 Flammable Gas Control

This course discusses the physical properties of flammable gases and the handling flammable gas emergencies. This course will provide the knowledge and skills to successfully mitigate flammable gas leaks and fires by discussing fire suppression and vapor control techniques and providing a familiarization to different gas system components. Students will gain a knowledge base in the classroom and then conclude the course by participating in several live fire exercises.
