#### **Minutes**

- Call to Order: 6:30PM
- Approval February 17, 2021 TAC Meeting Minutes. Moved by Karen. Second by Tom. All in favor with David abstaining.
- Making Rural Communities Safer for Walkers and Bikers John Kaplan covered four topics: low cost improvements to make streets safe for walking and biking, what are Complete Streets, sidewalk design basics, and overview of design resources. His presentation is available on the <u>TAC website</u>. Low cost improvements include:
  - o narrow travel lanes
  - o marking shoulders as bike lanes
  - o maintaining and sweeping existing shoulders
  - o enhancing sign visibility
  - o providing crosswalks, ensuring their visibility, and enhancing them
  - o providing sidewalks
  - o maintaining pedestrian infrastructure in the winter
  - o providing bike parking
- Project Prioritization, Initial Overview Mike W. went over the projects in VTrans
  existing Capital Program, the projects VTrans has identified from an asset driven
  perspective, and a list of potential projects of regional significance. The projects are listed
  on the TAC website. At the April meeting the TAC will review scoring on the asset
  driven potential projects and regionally driven projects identified by the TAC. The TAC
  asked Mike to provide more details on three project for consideration:
  - o US 7/Charles Ave./Monroe St. intersection in Middlebury
  - o US 7/Boardman St. intersection in Middlebury

- VT 116 road widening east of Bristol Village to Rockydale
- Transportation Updates from Mike
  - o Vermont State Rail Plan comments due March 22, 2021
  - o <u>Airport System Plan</u> review public meeting 3/24@6pm
  - New Haven train station New Haven, VTrans and ACRPC continue to meet to try and find an acceptable new site for the train station
  - Vergennes PEL Study up-date consultant selection process is still on-going
  - o April TAC elections Mike W. reminded the TAC of up-coming elections. If anyone is interested in the chair or vice-chair positions, please let him know.
  - Up-coming grant opportunities
    - AARP Community Challenge Grants Due April 14
    - Rise VT Amplify Grants Due April 15 with a second round in August restricted to Bristol, Lincoln, Starksboro, and Bridport. Max \$1,500
- Other Business/Roundtable (10 minutes)
  - Norm asked if Ripton had signed on to the Public Works Mutual Aid agreement.
     Mike indicated they had not. Norm will follow up with the town.
  - o Tom shared that a quad had fallen through the ice on Lake Dunmore
  - Mike A. expressed his hope that a solution to the New Haven train depot situation could be found that would preserve the building. He also reported that he had spoken with Aaron Brown, the New Haven Town Administrator, about the VT17/Hallock Road intersection, one of the potential projects Mike W. brought to the TAC. The comment at town meeting that prompted concern about the intersection was a brief conversation and no serious follow-up was required.
